
## Fall Fellowship Recap

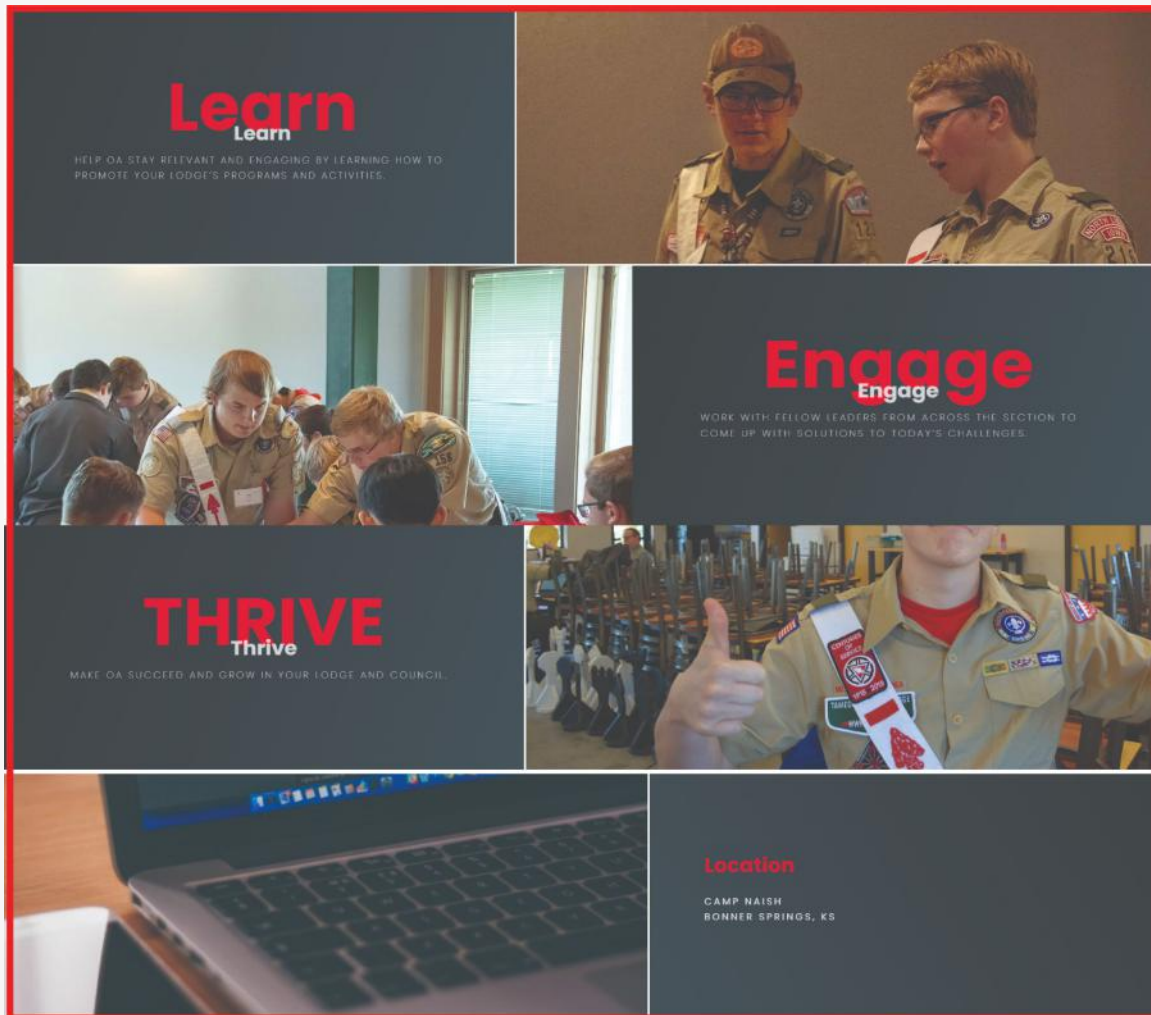

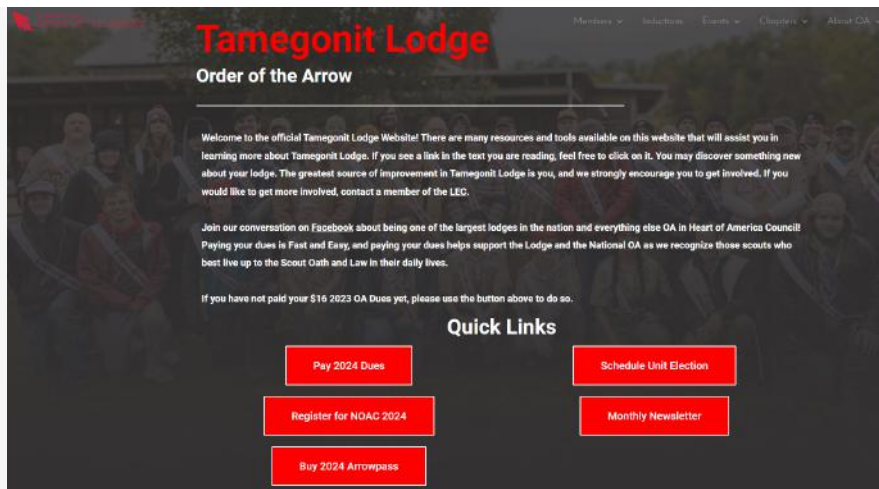


## Time to Pay Your 2024 Dues!
